Use of BBQs, Hog Roast & Other Outdoor Cooking Involving Heat.

If caterers are serving food at your event, please ensure they hold appropriate insurance to cover any damage to the hall and grounds. Please remember you are ultimately responsible for all damages. You should also check they hold appropriate food hygiene certificates.

With BBQ's and other outdoor cooking involving heat, please follow these guidelines.

- Have a bucket of water to hand.
- Site the BBQ/heat source well away from the building, fences, trees, shrubs, or any other flammable items. (We suggest at least 2 meters)
- Ensure any coals or charcoal is well extinguished after use and taken with you when you leave. DO NOT PUT USED COALS OR CHARCOAL IN THE BINS AT THE HALL.
- Do not use heat outdoors during very dry periods.

We strongly recommend considering an event insurance policy if holding an event involving BBQs or similar. This is to ensure you are covered for any injury or damage associated with heat. An internet search for 'event insurance' will bring up companies offering appropriate policies.

If you are using caterers, please ensure they are aware of the above.
